

### THE SPEECH PROJECT

Thursday 18 October @ 8.30pm

Four years in the making, The Speech Project is ground-breaking collection of new musical works by Gerry Diver. Inspired by and incorporating recordings of the spoken word of seminal Irish folk musicians including; Shane MacGowan, Christy Moore, Damien Dempsey, Joe Cooley, Danny Meehan and more.

Gerry Diver, a musician, composer and producer, born into an Irish family in Manchester relocated to Ireland in his teens. Former member of Irish world music group Sin é and Shane McGowan's The Popes, as well as guest musician with among others Van Morrison and uber-rock producer Youth. Recently Gerry has begun to focus on production and composing, working out of his studio in South London.

In 2007 he produced the Mojo Folk Album of the Year and the BBC Folk Award nominated album 'Wild And Undaunted' by Lisa Knapp. By this stage he had already begun work on The Speech Project, travelling to Ireland to make face-to-face recordings.

The show features musicians; Gerry Diver, Colman Connolly, Jonathan Hennessey-Brown, Gaz Wilkins, Declan Daly and Tomos Brangwyn. There are specially commissioned accompanying videos for selected works funded by Arts Council Ireland's Deis fund. All are interacting live with the spoken word recordings of the Irish musicians used in the Speech Project recordings.

### **Nine Tales Of The Pendulum** Album Launch Tour

Mick Coady's Synergy brings together five truly great young jazz musicians from the UK, Ireland and the US. Featuring renowned composer and alto saxophonist David Binney. The concert is part of a UK/Ireland tour celebrating the release of *Nine Tales Of The Pendulum*, Coady's debut album.

Although tightly rooted in the jazz tradition Mick Coady's original work reveals another side of his musical character, one that draws its inspiration from a range of influences. The rich harmony and angular melodies prominent in his compositions are a result of his long emersion in the jazz idiom. However, the epic song forms and intense grooves that underlie many of his pieces are evidence of an earlier exposure to rock and folk, and more recently African and Brazilian traditional music forms.
